Report from national RGBA call, 4-28-11

2010 LEED-H registrations - started with about 2,000 in January; 22,218 units registered by year end.
Gradual progress to 10,000 in Nov., then a jump to total.

- Single family - 2,822
- Multi family - 19,396
- Affordable - 9,580
- Market rate - 12,638

2010 LEED-H certifications - 5,117 units certified

- Single family - 1,646
- Multi family - 3,471
- Affordable - 2,569
- Market rate - 2,548

Cumulative LEED-H total units registered - 50,812

- Single family - 10,421
- Multi family - 40,391
- Affordable - 18,848
- Market rate - 31,963

Cumulative LEED-H total units certified - 11,255

- Single family - 5,140
- Multi family - 6,115
- Affordable - 5,378
- Market rate - 5,877

Estimate LEED-H has 4% of market share

Scoring Tool being made easier to use; kick the tires; zip code is most important: system cross-checks local window requirements; Phase 2 will be more streamlined and climate specific, e.g., HERS scores for north and south
